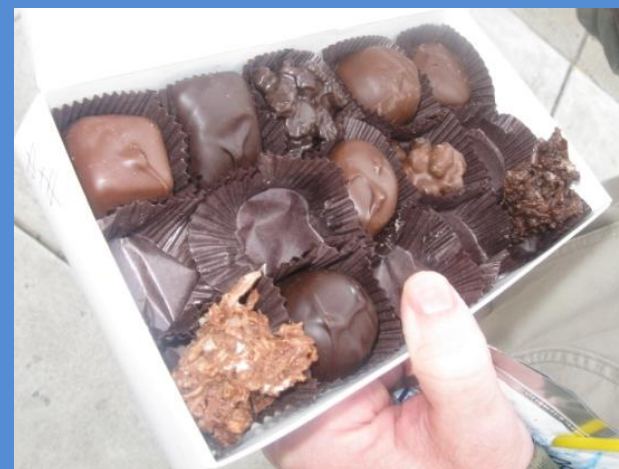
## Sweeties
